AN EMPTY BOWL IS A SYMBOL OF HUNGER. In support of our neighbors coping with food insecurity, Barnabas is hosting our 7th annual Empty Bowls event to raise awareness and funds to combat hunger and crisis in Nassau County. Local restaurants are donating a simple meal of soup, bread and dessert. In addition, each guest will receive a beautiful hand-painted bowl to take home. Potters and volunteers throughout the area have painted ceramic bowls so that each attendee can have a permanent reminder of the many bowls we still need to fill to provide nourishment to our neighbors who struggle with hunger.







WHY NASSAU NEEDS EMPTY BOWLS

THE REALITY OF NASSAU'S HUNGER PROBLEM

In Nassau County, more than 7,000 of our neighbors are rarely sure how they'll get enough to eat in the next few days. Over 2,000 of them are children. During the COVID-19 pandemic, demand for food has more than tripled.

OUR ONGOING HUNGER SOLUTION

Barnabas operates a large Food Pantry in east Nassau County where we work with our partners to distribute yearly over 380,000 pounds of food, equating to 318,515 meals, to our neighbors in need. Barnabas also provides food to individuals and families in need in Callahan and Hilliard. Without such help, these families often go hungry. To meet the increased demand during the COVID-19 pandemic, Barnabas significantly expanded food distribution sites across the county and established new community partnerships to feed thousands more families with fresh and nutritious food.

THE REALITY OF NASSAU'S HEALTHCARE PROBLEM

An estimated 10,000 people in our county lack health insurance. Uninsured, lower income adults have significant medical needs, but they have limited options for adequate and affordable care. They're often forced to ignore controllable health issues until an emergency room is the only choice. During the COVID-19 pandemic, patients continued to seek medical care from Barnabas and mobile medical care was established.

OUR ONGOING HEALTHCARE SOLUTION

Barnabas Health Services provides low cost medical care and dental care for our uninsured neighbors in need, integrating both primary and preventative services, improving their health and reducing the wasteful burden on emergency resources. During the COVID-19 pandemic, Barnabas provided telehealth medical services and remained open for emergency medical and dental services.

THE REALITY OF NASSAU'S POVERTY PROBLEM

Many Nassau families are one paycheck away from crisis. Approximately 7,000 Nassau County residents live at or below the federal poverty guidelines. Their families' personal resources are stretched beyond the limit. During the COVID-19 pandemic, Barnabas significantly increased our support to stabilize housing situations and help with critical household expenses. Thousands of locals who have never sought help before are looking to us for help and we have pledged to meet their needs for as long as we can.

THE EMPTY BOWLS SOLUTION

Empty Bowls is a grassroots effort to combat hunger and all its residual effects. Our goal is to help raise awareness in our community, to continue the battle against hunger, food insecurity and poverty by connecting people with the help and hope they need to become self-sufficient.
