Since 2014, this beloved community event has enabled us to raise funds that battle food insecurity and poverty throughout Nassau County. 1 We Help Thousands in Our Community

We are the sole safety net organization in Nassau County providing help and hope to community members in need.

2 We Multiply Every Donated Dollar

A donation of \$1 to Barnabas Center enables our nutrition services department to purchase \$7-\$10 worth of food, thanks to wholesale purchasing power and partnerships with large-scale food banks and local farms.

3 Our New to You Resale Stores Support Our Mission

Whenever anyone donates or purchases items from one of our three resale stores (including the online store BarnabasNewtoYouResale.org), it creates revenue that we use to provide services needed by Nassau County residents.

4 We Consistently Rank in the Top 1% of Nonprofits

For the 17th year in a row, Barnabas Center received the highest 4-star independent rating from Charity Navigator for exceptional fiscal and organizational management.

5 We Provide Low-Cost Health Care to Adults

Last year, 1,208 uninsured adults received low-cost or free medical, dental, behavioral health, telehealth and/or vision services through 4,403 separate service encounters.

6 We Save Money Through Our Valued Volunteers

Our generous group of 496 volunteers provided more than 14,420 hours of service last year, enabling us to operate efficiently and saving us \$399,146.

7 The Medical Services We Provide are Worth Millions

The Barnabas Center Health Services Clinic and its partners provide uninsured and underserved adults low-cost health services donated by our partners: Baptist Health System, Mayo Clinic Foundation and other specialty providers. Last year alone, the value of these in-kind services totaled \$2.8 million.

8 We Stabilize Households in Crisis

Our empowerment programs provided rent, mortgage and/or utility assistance to 263 households so they could remain in their homes last year.

9 Our Nutrition Services Department Impact 25,000+ People

Our nutrition services department helped feed 35,339 people last year by processing 644,140 pounds of healthy food.

10 We Deliver Hope

Many don't realize that the largest growing population experiencing hunger or food insecurity is working families. We bridge the gap by providing healthy, fresh food for everyone – from seniors to veterans to families just trying to make ends meet.
