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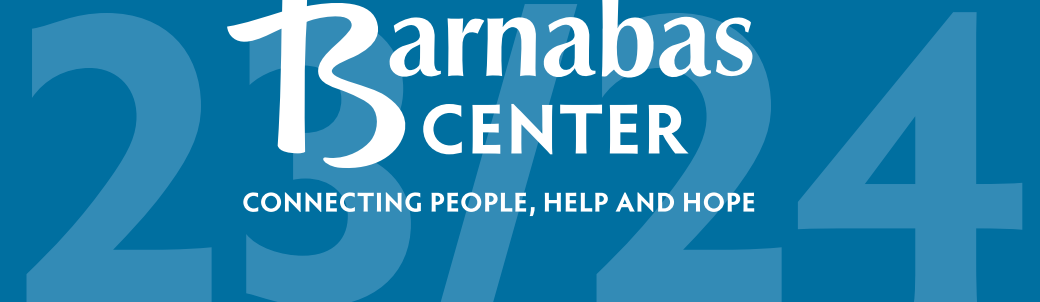
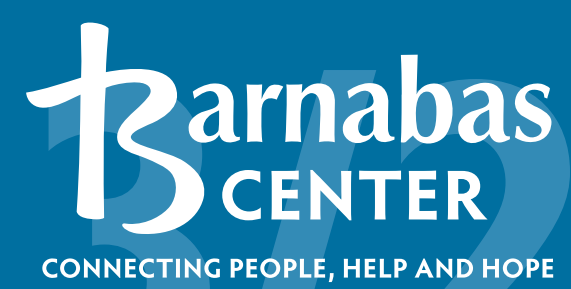

We are Nassau County's only comprehensive service center devoted to helping those in need thrive as healthy citizens. Barnabas Center believes every individual has an opportunity to lead a healthy and productive life, thereby strengthening our entire community.

## HOW YOU INSPIRE HOPE

Katie moved to Amelia Island after serving prison time and losing custody of her daughters. She knew she needed to rebuild her life. While completing her community service at our New to You Resale Store, she met our resource coordinator who helped her create a plan to reunite with her daughters. Katie's hard work paid off with a new job in the hospitality industry. A few months later she regained custody of her daughters, one of which sought help herself at Barnabas Center for help with college prep. "I've also relied on the food pantry and accessed medical services," Katie said. "But what stands out most is how deeply the team cares." ## EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMS

**346 households avoided homelessness**

with rent/mortgage/utility payment assistance, totaling \$159,424. Case-management services were provided to 532 individuals, including GED instruction, assistance with food stamp/Medicaid applications, resume writing, job coaching and more.



## NUTRITION SERVICES

**650,130 pounds of healthy food**

was processed for distribution to 37,366 food insecure people. More than 15,722 children were served. Our Nutrition Services program served 3,538 different households.



## HEALTH SERVICES

**1,028 uninsured adults received low-cost or free**

medical, dental, behavioral health, telehealth and/or vision services through 5,316 separate service encounters.



**\$2.1 million in health care services**

was donated by Baptist Health, Baptist Medical Center Nassau, doctors, specialists, prescription assistance programs and other health care providers.



## OUTREACH

**319 community partnership outreach activities**

were conducted for an average of 27 per month. Examples of our outreach involvement include our annual school supply drive, Holiday Adopt-A-Family Program, health fair exhibitions and other events.



## SERVICES PROVIDED

**21,721 services**

were provided to local women, men and children in need across all programs.



## SEEDS OF HOPE

**62 pounds of produce**

were grown in the first three months of planting at the new on-site community garden.



## BARNABAS CENTER NEW TO YOU RESALE STORE

**57 households in need**

received furnishings, clothing or other household items through our resale store. Proceeds support our programs and services.



## VOLUNTEERS

**589 volunteers**

assisted individually and/or through their companies, churches or civic groups, totaling

**16,963 hours**

of service valued at \$536,200.



## KIDS MEAL PACKS

**186 children**

at risk of homelessness in our local community received more than 3,900 weekend meal packs to prevent hunger.
